Caring Hands Food Bank - Appeal for donations

You may have heard on the news that food banks are currently hard-pressed to meet local needs; this is true of Caring Hands in Evesham. Can we please do an emergency food bank collection? My contact sent the following: "We are spending a lot of money each week at the moment on food for the food bank. We have been very grateful to Tesco and Morrisons for extra collections, but we still are struggling to keep up with demand. A collection by the churches would be wonderful. Please – **no beans or pasta!** We also have plenty of cereals at the moment. We are running short of tins of main meals – meatballs, Irish Stew, Beans and sausages mixed, chicken in white sauce, pasta sauce jars, custard, Tuna, Sardines, Jacobs or own brand crackers / savoury biscuits, flavoured pasta meals – dried, smash style mashed potato, UHT milk – not skimmed. Any of those things would be amazing!"
St Peter's Bengeworth will be open all week, as usual, and I will collect whatever is on the large wooden table at the back on Tuesday 28th August at 2.00 pm and deliver the goods to Caring Hands.
