at St Peter's Bengeworth 7.30pm to 9.00pm

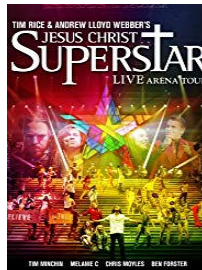
