Superstar - ASUM South Lent Course

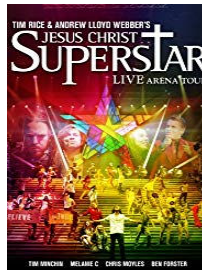
at St Peter's Bengeworth starting Thursday 7.30pm

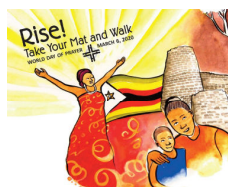
