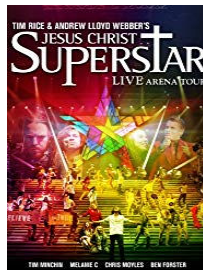


## Superstar - ASUM South Lent Course

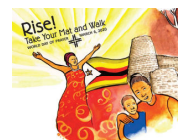
