Don't forget to include details of your meetings and events through to early March.

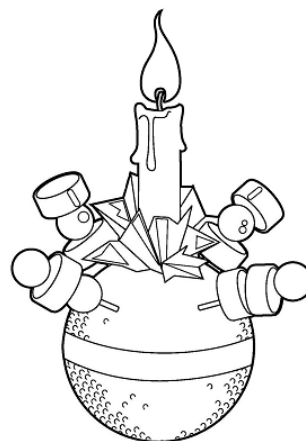
