The full timetable is still being finalised but here are details of some of the things definitely booked:

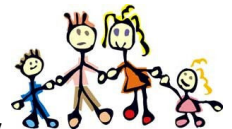
The Launch Event will be on Friday 15th June, 7.30pm in Evesham Town Hall.
