envelope.

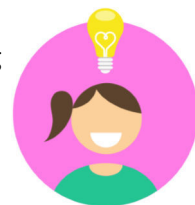

Two people meet at school and maintain a correspondence throughout their lives, charting a complex and intriguing relationship.

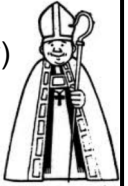
