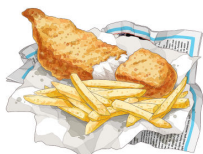

19th March - The Psalms

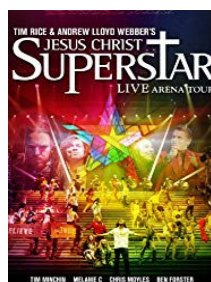
