### **Bishop's Certificate Course 2015-2016**

Rev Andrew Spurr assisted by ALM/Reader in training Andy Green propose to lead a Bishop's Certificate Course commencing Wednesday 28 October, 2015. There will be approximately 30 sessions which will take place on Wednesday evenings, at Church House, Evesham commencing at 7.30pm and finishing at 9.00pm. The cost to participate will be approximately £25 payable at the first session. The Bishop will present Certificates to all those who complete the Course, in a ceremony at Worcester Cathedral on 8th November 2016.

This is a course designed to help you learn more about the bible, the great themes of Christian faith and life, and to relate these to your own experience and locality. It will encourage you to explore and reflect as you learn with – and from – the other people on your course. It's a great way to get to know people from neighbouring churches and different Christian traditions. We need a minimum of six participants to run the Course.
