### Hampton Envelope Scheme

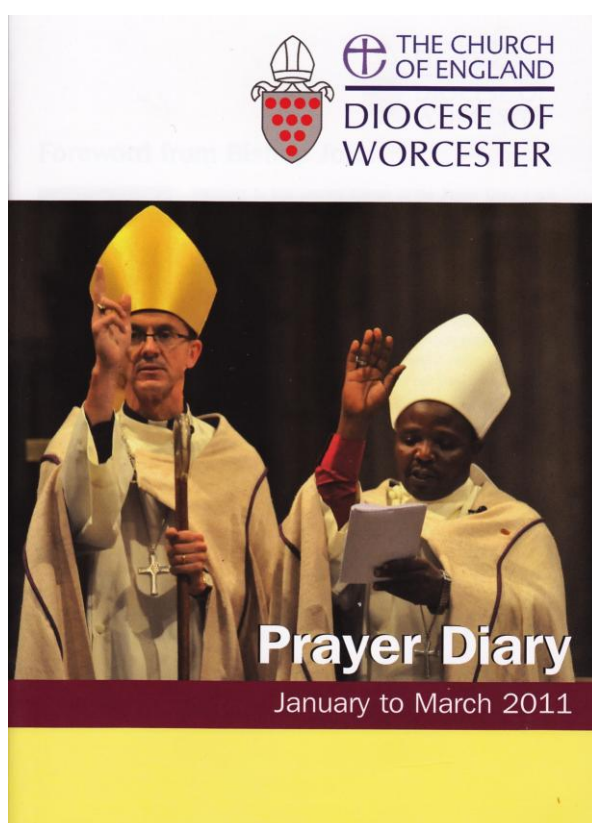
