For those who bear responsibility of leadership and responsibility in our churches and wider benefice.

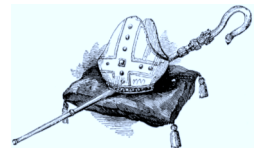

Bengeworth Church Flora Fest Saturday 24th and Sunday 25th June

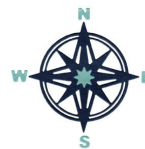
