We keep in mind...

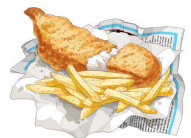
Everyone hit by Hurricane Michael, for those who died and those who have lost their homes and communities.

The plate collection on Sunday 7th raised £71.00. Thank you.

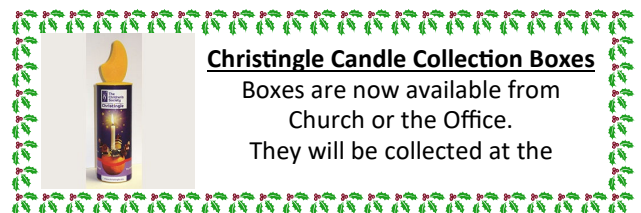
